Westbourne Academy can arrange accommodation for students who take courses at the school. Most students choose homestay accommodation because it is an important part of the experience and involves living as a member of the home. Students are treated as a full member of the household, eating together and sharing the common living areas. It gives them the opportunity to practise their English and benefit from an English home atmosphere. Please note that we do not place more than four students in one homestay.

Some students prefer 'Private Home Accommodation'. There may be less of a 'family' environment in these homes as there can be more than 4 students at the home. Students will still eat together with the hosts and share the common living areas. If you prefer to be placed in 'Private Home Accommodation' please let us know at the time of booking on the enrolment form.

- All homestays/Private Home Accommodation are carefully selected by the Academy's accommodation department
- All homestays/Private Home Accommodation are regularly inspected by our Accommodation Officer
- Special diets can be arranged with advance notice. This is offered at an extra cost:

- Students aged 16 and 17 years old must return home by 10.30pm Sunday – Thursday and 11.30pm on Friday and Saturday
- Students aged 14 and 15 years old must return home by 9.30pm every day.

What is included?

- All bookings include bed, breakfast and an evening meal per day. A snack lunch is provided at weekends. No lunch is provided on weekdays unless requested in writing.
- Bedrooms will have a mirror, wardrobe and drawer space for clothes together with a desk, chair and lamp for students to have a place to study
- Bedrooms are cleaned once a week
- Clean bed linen is provided and fitted weekly at no extra charge
- One load of clothes washing per week is included at no extra charge. Additional washing is arranged at the discretion of the homestay.
- All students receive a front door key. For students aged under-18, the key will be kept in an agreed place in the home while they are at home.
- We recommend all of our students to make sure they have medical insurance before they arrive in the UK. We recommend all students register with their homestay provider's doctor.

Twin room accommodation is sharing a room with another student. Accommodation is **part board** Monday to Friday with breakfast and evening meals. A snack lunch is provided at weekends. Lunch is available in the **school cafeteria** during the week at an **additional cost**.

A large number of homestay providers have pets such as cats and dogs. We can only guarantee a family without pets if a medical certificate is provided in advance stating an allergy.

Please note that accommodation bookings are Saturday to Saturday, unless otherwise arranged.

BOOKING DETAILS 2022

- All **course books** are loaned free of charge but can be bought by students.
- All **lessons** are **40 minutes**.
- **English Plus** includes additional General English and Conversational English classes.
- The **maximum number of students** in a class is 16.
- Our **average class size** in the Summer is 12. Our **average class size** the rest of the year is 10.
- Courses are normally held between **9.30 am – 12.30 pm and/or 1.30 pm – 4.30 pm** Monday to Friday, depending on the student's level. The **Junior Programme** is between **9.00 am – 12.00 pm** Monday to Friday
- Students **cannot** choose the lesson times under any circumstances.
- **Examination practice materials** are available to borrow for all examinations listed at the bottom of this page.
- **IELTS examinations** can be arranged throughout the year when required. Students must be studying for a minimum of 8 weeks before the date of the examination.
