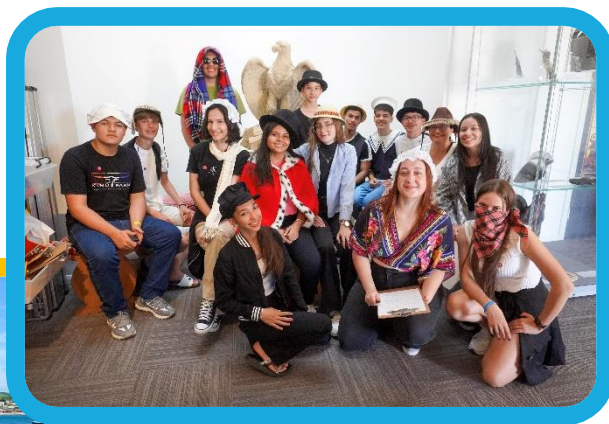

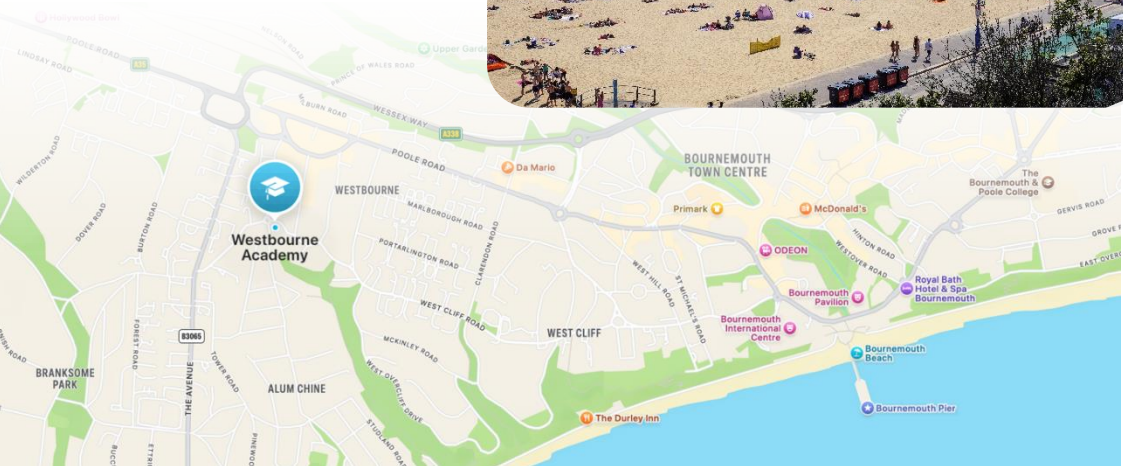

OUR LOCATION

Situated in the beautiful seaside town of Bournemouth, we benefit greatly from our incredible surroundings and take full advantage of them, with optional daily social activities and weekend excursions to the beaches, New Forest and local attractions. The school is located near the picturesque shopping centre of Westbourne and in this safe and friendly part of Bournemouth, you will find banks, a post office, international restaurants, and great shopping facilities. The beach is only 10 minutes' walk and Bournemouth town centre is 5 minutes away by bus. The historic town of Poole is also just 20 minutes away by bus and Christchurch is 30 minutes away.



JUNIOR PROGRAMME

12–17-YEAR-OLDS

Our exciting Junior Programme is available for students aged 12 – 17 years old to study for 1 week or more. This programme promotes the interaction of students of similar ages and interests from around the world.

JUNIOR COURSE OPTIONS

Students aged 12-15 must be part of a group booking with a maximum stay of 3 weeks. Students aged 16-17 who are not part of a group booking can only join the Junior Programme during the Summer Term (29th June – 14th August; subject to availability).

DAILY TIMETABLE AND SOCIAL PROGRAMME

On the Junior Programme, students have the same daily timetable. Lessons are Monday to Friday, and the day starts at 9:00am with four lessons per day and finishes at 12:00pm followed by lunch. (each lesson is 40 minutes). Students booked onto the Full Programme have a hot lunch from 12:00pm – 1:20pm and an afternoon activity arranged by Westbourne Academy from Tuesday to Thursday with one full day excursion each week. Students are welcome to join the activity programme if they have not booked the Full Junior Programme and pay for each activity, they wish to take part in.

HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION

Homestay accommodation is an important part of the programme experience and involves living as a member of the home. Students are treated as a full member of the household, eating together and sharing the common living areas. Living with local people is the best way to get extra language practice and it also helps you to understand English culture and customs. Often students staying (even if only for a short time) become so happy in the homestay that they come back to visit!

WHAT BENEFITS ARE THERE OF HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION?

- A warm welcome is provided to students on arrival making the transition from one culture to another much easier.
- Homestays are full of local knowledge and can assist with any questions or concerns you have as well as recommending great things to do during your stay
- All our homestays are carefully selected by the Academy's accommodation department with regular inspections and a thorough application process.
- You will feel like part of the family and invited to join activities with the homestay.
- Special diets can be arranged with advanced notice so you are sure to be well fed! Please note this may cost extra. Please ask your agency for more details on these.
- Students have a curfew to ensure they are home safely from activities
- All the homestays are located within one area so students can travel together



WHAT'S INCLUDED?

- Fully furnished twin bedroom with space for your clothes and a desk, chair and lamp where you can study (Students 16+ can request a single room for a higher cost)
- Shared shower or bathroom and toilet facilities
- Breakfast and evening meal Monday to Friday
- Breakfast, snack lunch and evening meals Saturday and Sunday
- Packed lunch if going on a weekend excursion.
- One wash load of clothes per week.
- Weekly bed linen and towels are provided
- A front door key to use during your stay
- Free Wi-Fi

Please note that accommodation bookings are Saturday to Saturday, unless otherwise arranged.

STUDENT WELFARE AND SAFETY

Students are provided with a wristband on their first day at school that has the 24-hour emergency phone number on it (Yellow band for 12–15-year-olds, blue band for 16 – 17 year olds). This band is worn at all times during their programme to ensure they are always able to contact us in an emergency.

With weekly meetings for our junior students, we are able to keep an eye on students and make sure they are happy and settling well on the programme. We get to know them and build a trusting relationship that allows them to tell us of any worries they may be having so that we can help.



All our Junior Homestays have been carefully selected and have had police checks to ensure that the students are living in a safe environment. The homestays are located on a main bus route that has regular buses every 10 minutes and we also place 14 – 15-year-old students in twin rooms in a homestay to ensure they are never travelling alone.
