






Location

Accommodation



- Homestay provider accommodation available for all our students.
- Accommodation officer and Assistant.
- Regular inspections and feedback from students' questionnaires.
- Cheaper accommodation than other schools in Bournemouth: average of £15-£30 per week.
- What is included: half board accommodation, FREE WIFI, 1 laundry per week, sit down meal with the HP, we ask the HP and encourage the student to take part in the home life.
- Carefully selected homestays in defined catchment area: Parkstone, Branksome or Westbourne.
 Maximum distance of 20 min by bus (regular lines)
 - √ For Junior Programme will be on M1/M2 (every 8 minutes) routes only.



Social Programme



- Two/ three social activities per week (one normally for free).
 - ✓ Bowling, laser quest, Rock Reef climbing, Hengistbury Head walks, International Parties, beach volleyball, table tennis, football, quizzes, barbeques, boat trips...
- Excursions arranged to:
 - ✓ Oxford, Bath, London, Jurassic Coast, Winchester, Boat cruise to Swanage
 - ✓ Some of them are organised by a private company (especially in the winter months).
 - ✓ If students are going on their own, we offer help at reception.
